

Punjab Civil Secretariat-II, Sector 9, Chandigarh to treat the present petition as representation and decide the same expeditiously. The learned competent authority shall also examine as to whether the case of the petitioner falls within the parameters of law laid down by this Court in CWP-11054-2020, titled as Manpreet Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others decided on 6.8.2020. The needful be done within twelve weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. In case, the learned competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the case of the petitioner is not covered by the ratio of law laid down in CWP-11054-2020, the petitioner shall have the liberty to revive the present petition within three months thereafter.

During the pendency of the matter before the learned competent authority, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner.

Disposed of in the above terms.
