Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 166 dated 13.08.2020 registered under Sections 452, 379-B, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Batala, District Batala (Gurdaspur).

This Court, on 11.09.2020, passed the following order:

“Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 166 dated 13.08.2020 registered under Sections 452,

379-B, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Batala, District Batala (Gurdaspur).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the complainant and the petitioner are co-villagers and immediate neighbours. The petitioner had no intention to stare at the house of the petitioner and rather the petitioner was in love-affairs with the daughter of the complainant and it was due to this grudge, the present FIR has been got registered. He further states that in future, the petitioner will mend his ways and will never stare toward the house of the complainant.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Ajay Pal Singh Gill, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Adjourned to 13.01.2021.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and if he is sought to be arrested, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer subject to the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 11.09.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from A.S.I. Baldev Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not

required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 11.09.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
