SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of appropriate directions to official respondents No.1 to 4 to register an FIR against General Diary No.028 dated 09.02.2021 (Annexure P-1). A further direction has been sought to respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 29.07.2021 (Annexure P-2) and to register an FIR against the private respondents for having caused grievous injuries to the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a 65 years' old lady and she has a dispute with Dev Singh S/o Mahinder Singh and she had submitted an application to the Executive Officer, Dharamkot in this connection. When she stopped Dev Singh from constructing a wall in the

street, he along with his relations, attacked the petitioner with sword and iron rod and caused grievous injuries to her, regarding which a General Diary No.028 was recorded on 09.02.2021 (Annexure P-1). He submits that despite the recording of incident in the General Diary and submission of representation dated 29.07.2021 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.3, no action has been taken by the official respondents. Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned respondent to look into the representation.

Request made by counsel for the petitioner has been considered.

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations made in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Moga – respondent No.3 to examine the representation dated 29.07.2021 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of the representation (Annexure P-2) along with a copy of this order be communicated to respondent No.3 so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
