This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to official respondents not to conduct repeated inquiries in case FIR No.132 dated 06.07.2020 under Sections 120-B, 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Guru Harsahai, District Ferozepur, as per order dated 14.01.2009 passed by D.G.P. Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that grievance of the petitioner would be redressed in case the instant petition is treated as representation on behalf of the petitioner and if the same is ordered to be disposed of by respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, District Ferozepur, in a time bound manner.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, District Ferozepur, to treat the instant petition as representation and to look into and decide the same in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within four weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
