1. This petition has been filed under Article 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India seeking direction to respondents to release admissible export incentive namely duty drawback of the petitioner amount to Rs. 23,06,867/- on account of exports made during September 2019 to December 2019.

2. The main grievance of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that despite representation having been made in this regard to respondents No.1 and 2 no duty drawback has been paid to the petitioner and at this stage, he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondents No.1 and 2 to decide the representation filed by the petitioner.

3. We find this to be a fair request and dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the respondents No.1 and 2 to decide the prayer of the petitioner

regarding duty drawback in accordance with law within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. Since the main case has been decided, the pending miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
