The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., with two fold prayers one for direction to carry out the fair and transparent investigation by transferring the investigation to some independent investigating agency or to some Police Officer out of Rohtak Range in case FIR No. 62 dated 23.04.2021 under Sections 323, 34, 376, 377, 406, 498A and 506 IPC, Police Station Women, Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar and second for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner herein and her minor children.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Mahima Yashpal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Learned State counsel would submit that after completing the investigation the challan in the matter already stands presented as far back as 18.08.2021.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the matter.

This Court does not deem fit to direct or refer the matter to any other investigating agency as in case the petitioner herein is not satisfied with the investigation done, she is at liberty to challenge the same in appropriate proceedings.

However, since there is an apprehension of private respondents No. 6 to 8 causing harm to the petitioner herein and her minor children, she is at liberty to approach the official respondents for seeking protection. In case, any such application is moved, necessary action will be taken thereon in accordance with law.

The instant petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid observation.
