1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.225 dated 21.07.2020, registered under Sections 326, 323, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court to move a petition for regular bail and directions being issued to the learned trial Court to consider and decide the petition for regular bail, in a time bound manner.

4. The same is not opposed to by learned State counsel as well as counsel for the complainant.

5. Accordingly, in view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is

dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty as prayed for. In the

eventuality of the petitioner moving a petition for regular bail before the learned trial Court, the learned trial Court is directed to consider and decide the same in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter as expeditiously as possible.
