Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to take appropriate action on the representation dated 14.07.2021 as respondent Nos.4 to 8 have committed a fraud by withdrawing the amount of Rs.9.00 lacs from the account of the petitioner and it was transferred in the account of respondent No.4 – Simranpreet Kaur.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that respondent No.4 – Simranpreet Kaur has performed marriage with respondent No.5 – Sukhpreet Singh and vide order dated 01.04.2021, passed in CRWP No.3173 of 2021, protection has been granted with regard to performing the marriage against the wishes of the parents of respondent No.4 – Simranpreet Kaur.

Counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that on that pretext, the police is not taking any action. It is also submitted that thereafter CRM-W No.776 of 2021, was filed in the aforesaid CRWP

CASE HEARD THROUGH VIDEO CONFERENCING

No.3173 of 2021, for issuing a direction to the respondent No.2/ Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar, to hold a meeting of the applicant/respondents i.e. parents of Simranpreet Kaur with her and notice has been issued for 22.09.2021.

Counsel for the State has submitted that the police will decide the representation of the petitioner independent of the direction issued in CRWP No.3173 of 2021 as the same are relating only to granting protection to the life and liberty of respondent No.4 – Simranpreet Kaur and respondent No.5 – Sukhpreet Singh despite the fact that the petitioner – Shubhkarman Singh is arrayed as respondent No.6 in the said petition.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural), District Amritsar, to decide the representation of the petitioner independently, in accordance with law.
