The petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents to consider his case for the post of Clerk under SC category vide advertisement No. 5/2019 date of publication 20.06. 2019. His case is that he has secured 65 marks and the cut off marks in the SC category are 63 marks.

After notice, short reply has been filed on behalf of the respondents. In para 5 of the short reply, it is stated that the final result was declared on 03.09.2020 and the petitioner has secured total 62 marks (57 marks in written examination and 5 marks in socio-economic criteria) and not 65 marks as alleged by him. The last selected candidate in SC category has secured 63 marks.

Since the petitioner has secured only 62 marks, the writ petition is dismissed.
