The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 21.03.2020 (Annexure P-6) with a further prayer to issue a direction to the respondents to count the daily wage service of the petitioners for their retiral benefits, as per Rules.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if the respondents pass a speaking order on his legal notice dated 21.03.2020 (Annexure P-6) within a time frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Rathee, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Even counsel for the respondents is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioners.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice issued by the petitioners dated 21.03.2020 (Annexure P-6) and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that if the petitioners are found entitled to any pecuniary benefits upon such a conscious decision; then the said pecuniary benefits shall also be released to the petitioners within a further period of three months; from the date of such conscious decision of the authorities.
