The petitioners have come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *certiorari* for quashment of letter/order (Annexure P-3) and order dated 23.04.2019 (Annexure P-4) whereby the claim of the petitioner No. 1 has been rejected with further prayer to issue writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents No. 2 to 10 to decide the legal notices (Annexure P-5 to P-12) qua petitioners No. 2 to 10 which are yet to be decided.

If the petitioners are held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to them without any delay.
