The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

As per the office report, notice issued to the respondent has been received back served through the trial Court counsel.

However, the respondent remains unrepresented.

On 17.08.2021, the following order was passed:-

“The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This petition has been filed by the wife seeking the transfer of the case bearing No.DMC/133/2021, titled as “Jasveer Singh Vs. Renu”, pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Ferozepur/Camp Court at Zira to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Jalandhar.

The petitioner claims that she got married to the respondent on 24.03.2019 and they have been blessed with one female child. She claims that presently, she is residing with her parents at Jalandhar and the distance between Ferozepur/Camp Court at Zira and Jalandhar is 120 Kms. The petitioner further claims that she cannot properly defend the petition at Ferozepur/Camp Court at Zira.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner places reliance on the following litigations pending in District Courts, Jalandhar:-

(i) Petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C., for maintenance.

He contends that it will be very difficult for the petitioner to travel on each date of hearing.

Notice of motion for 03.09.2021.

The liberty is granted to the petitioner to serve the respondent through his counsel Sh. Manpreet Singh Sidhu, at District Courts, Ferozepur/Camp Court at Zira.

Dasti also.”

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, as noticed in the aforesaid order, the petition is allowed.

The petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing No.DMC/133/2021, titled as “Jasveer Singh Vs. Renu”, pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Ferozepur/Camp Court at Zira, is ordered to be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Jalandhar.

The transferor Court is requested to remit the case file to the transferee Court forthwith.

The petitioner through her counsel is directed to appear before the transferee Court on 23.09.2021.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
