At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition since the petitioner intends to surrender before the police and move application for regular bail. However, he has prayed that on account of the fact that the dispute has been settled between the parties and prosecutrix has got married with the petitioner/accused and they are residing together happily, the trial Court be directed to dispose of the application for regular bail expeditiously.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

It is directed that on petitioner surrendering before the police within seven days from today and moving an application for regular bail, the same be disposed of expeditiously by the Court of Sessions at Ludhiana keeping in view the position explained by learned counsel for the petitioner mentioned above.
