Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondents No.5 and 6 illegally entered into the property of the petitioner by breaking locks with the intention to get possession of the same and have also misappropriated the articles lying therein. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that a car belonging to the petitioner bearing No.PB-08-DU-9604 is still parked on the said property and the petitioner is also not being allowed to take out the said car.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has filed a complaint dated 28.07.2021 (Annexure P/8) with the police authorities, but no action has been taken by the police so far and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the complaint dated 28.07.2021

(Annexure P/8) submitted by the petitioner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the complaint dated 28.07.2021 (Annexure P/8) submitted by the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing appropriate speaking order.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in complaint dated 28.07.2021 (Annexure P/8), respondent No.2 is directed to decide complaint dated 28.07.2021 (Annexure P/8) submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
