This petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 115 CPC for setting aside the order dated 29.6.2021 (Annexure P-1), passed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Rohtak, and for issuing directions to the Executing Court to hear the execution application urgently and to use coercive measures to get the amount of enhanced compensation deposited; and for issuing direction to respondent No.1 to deposit the enhanced compensation without any delay.

The counsel for the petitioner submits that since the amount has already been deposited by the Insurance Company/respondent, therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
