This second petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in FIR No. 114, dated 15.10.2020, under Sections 15 and 29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, (Act 61 of 1985), registered at Police Station Sandaur, District Sangrur.

2. The brief facts of the case are that police party received a secret information that Sabir Khan, Mohd. Khalid were carrying narcotic substances and can be apprehended. Acting on the information on 15th October, 2020, both the accused were apprehended and 100 kg of poppy husk was recovered. Petitioner-Bhau @ Baag Hussain was nominated on the basis of statement of the co-accused and 25 kg poppy husk was recovered from him.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is in custody since 17th October, 2020, investigation is complete, the recovery was of non-commercial quantity and petitioner is not involved in any other

NDPS case. Co-accused was granted bail by this Court.

4. Learned State counsel opposes the prayer for grant of regular bail. He submits that total recovery including the recovery from the co-accused is 125 kg of poppy husk.

5. Considering the custody period of the petitioner and the facts that petitioner has no criminal antecedents, recovery made from him is of non-commercial quantity and co-accused was granted bail by this court, petitioner is granted bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.

6. The petition is allowed.

7. It is clarified that observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
