Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Prayer in the present 6th petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of interim regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No. 358 dated 08.09.2018, registered under Sections 34, 120-B, 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC and Sections 4, 5 and 6 of the Prize Chits and Money Circulation Scheme (Banning) Act, 1978, at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that earlier, the petitioner was released on interim regular bail for a period of 15 days, vide order dated 10.06.2021 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, which was extended for two weeks by this Court vide order dated 25.06.2021 and the petitioner was directed to surrender before the jail authorities on

10.07.2021. Thereafter, vide order dated 26.07.2021 passed in CRM-M-28987-2021, the petitioner was granted interim regular bail w.e.f. 31.07.2021 to 16.08.2021 in order to look after his three minor children and his ailing wife.

However, before the surrender of the petitioner on 16.08.2021, he has filed the present petition for interim regular bail on the ground that post surgery of his wife, he is required to look after her and take proper care of hers.

I do not find any merit in the aforesaid plea of the petitioner. As noticed above, the petitioner has already availed number of concessions of interim regular bail granted by this Court on the same very ground. Granting extension or any further interim bail to the petitioner would defeat the very cause of justified ground and would set a wrong precedents for the similarly placed accused.

No ground for grant of concession of interim bail to the petitioner is made out.
