This is a petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.51 dated 28.04.2020 under Sections 307, 353, 186, 332, 427, 506, 188, 269, 270, 271, 283, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 51 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 registered at Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda.

Vide order dated 15.09.2020 the arrest of the petitioner was stayed. Vide order dated 23.11.2020 the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from SI Bikramjeet Singh has stated that the petitioner has since joined the investigation and he is no longer required for further investigation at this stage.

In view of the above, the order dated 23.11.2020 is made absolute. The petitioner shall, however, join investigation as and when called. The petitioner shall also abide by all the terms and conditions as specified under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
