Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as respondents No. 7 to 17 were interfering in the peaceful possession of the land belonging to the petitioners, petitioners had approached Civil Court, wherein, the Civil Court restrained respondents No. 7 to 17 from dispossessing the petitioners from the land forcibly and illegally or interfering into their peaceful possession of the land but still, respondents No. 7 to 17 are not allowing the petitioners to peacefully possess the land in question. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners had already filed a representation dated 18.06.2021 (Annexure P-12) raising the said grievance to respondent No. 4-Deputy Superintendent of Police, Phillaur, Jalandhar, which is still

pending consideration and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the representation dated 18.06.2021 (Annexure P-12) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Kumar, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned State counsel raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 18.06.2021 (Annexure P-12) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, respondent No. 4 is directed to decide the representation dated 18.06.2021 (Annexure P-12) by passing a speaking order within a period of six weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present petition stands disposed of.
