1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for intentional and willful of defiance of order dated 14.12.2020 in CWP No. 21402 of 2020.
3. Issue notice to respondent No.1 to show cause as to why proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 be not initiated against him.
4. Mr. Sanjeev Soni, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and has placed on record copy of order dated 01.04.2021 accepting the claim of the petitioner passed pursuant to order dated 14.12.2020 in CWP No. 21402 of 2020. The same is taken on record. Copy therefore supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in the circumstances he does not press the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

5. Learned counsel for respondent No.1 states that in view of order dated 01.04.2021 having been passed by respondent No.1, in terms of order dated 14.12.2020 in CWP No. 21402 of 2020, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against respondent No.1.

5. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel for the parties.

6. In view of the position noted above as well as order dated 01.04.2021 having been passed by respondent No.1, there is sufficient compliance with order dated 14.12.2020 in CWP No. 21402 of 2020, as such no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against respondent No.1. Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as such.
