The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondent to release the pension/service benefits to the present petitioner, for which, legal notices dated 18.03.2021 and 26.05.2021 (Annexures P-2 and P-3) has also been served upon the respondent authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner side, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider legal notices dated 18.03.2021 and 26.05.2021 (Annexures P-2 and P-3) as representations of the petitioner

and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
