The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

As per the office report, notice issued to the respondent has been received back served through trial Court counsel.

On 17.08.2021, the following order was passed:-

“The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This petition has been filed by the wife seeking the transfer of the petition filed under Section 6 of the Hindu Minority & Guardianship Act, 1956 and Sections 8, 12 and 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890, bearing No.GW/74/2021, titled as “Vikas Vinayak Vs. Roopneet Kaur Pun” , pending in the Court of Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Ludhiana to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Amritsar.

The petitioner claims that she got married to the respondent on 26.01.2006 and they have been blessed with two children. She claims that presently she is residing with her aged parents at Amritsar. The petitioner further claims that she cannot properly defend the petition at Ludhiana. Notice of motion for 03.09.2021.

The liberty is granted to the petitioner to serve the respondent through his counsel Sh. Harkamal Singh, at District Courts, Ludhiana.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, in accordance with the aforesaid order, the petition is allowed.

The petition under Section 6 of the Hindu Minority & Guardianship Act, 1956 and Sections 8, 12 and 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890, bearing No.GW/74/2021, titled as “Vikas Vinayak Vs. Roopneet Kaur Punn”, pending in the Court of the Principal Judge Family Court, Ludhiana, is ordered to be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Amritsar.

The transferor Court is requested to remit the case file to the transferee Court forthwith.

The petitioner through her counsel is directed to appear before the transferee Court on 23.09.2021.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
