This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been moved by petitioner seeking protection to her life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.7 to 9.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation dated NIL to respondent No.5-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural), copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/2, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion confined to respondents No.1 to 6 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 6. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.5-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural), to look into and decide representation dated NIL (Annexure P/2) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
