The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* or any other writ, order or direction, for issuance of directions to the respondents to pay the amount of gratuity, compute pension, leave encashment, full pension to the petitioner as the same retirement benefits has not been paid to the petitioner from the date of retirement i.e. 31.10.2020 from the post of Assistant Engineer/SDO, till date by the respondent-Corporation, in spite of the fact that no charge sheet or inquiry is pending against the petitioner.

Upon hearing learned counsel of both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the respondents to consider the representation dated 16.07.2021 (Annexure P-4), moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
