Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of DDR No.53 dated 30.10.2020 (Annexure P-1) recorded under Sections 341, 323, 506, 149 IPC at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar, in FIR No.243 dated 30.10.2020 (Annexure P-2) registered under Sections 341, 323, 506 and 34 IPC at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar, along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 02.08.2021 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that with the intervention of respectables, the compromise has been effected between them.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Avtar Singh Sandhu, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State.

Mr. Vivek Gupta, Advocate, appears for respondent No.2 and

has not disputed the factum of the compromise effected between the parties.

At this stage, learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, points out that despite recording of DDR No.53 dated 30.10.2020 in FIR No.243 dated 30.10.2020 against the petitioners, they have not joined the investigation.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have not joined the investigation, no cause of action arises to quash the aforesaid DDR, at this stage.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
