G.S. Sandhawalia, J. (Oral):-

Petitioner, by way of the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, has sought consideration to appear in the interview whereby the candidates had been called for interview provisionally against the General Category against the earlier posts of SBC Category since 108 marks was the cut-off. Petitioner had filed the writ petition on account of the fact that he could not appear for interview on 25.05.2019, as per notice dated 02.05.2019 (Annexure P-5) and interim order was passed on 31.05.2019, for provisionally interviewing the petitioner and the result was to be kept in a sealed cover.

The result of the petitioner has now been produced in sealed cover which has been opened. A perusal of the same would go on to show that the petitioner has secured 108 marks in the written examination and 12 marks in the interview, total 120 marks. The final result dated 01.07.2021 has also been produced whereby the wait-list for the post of PGT, Chemistry has been kept at 136 marks. In such circumstances, it is apparent that the petitioner has failed to make the cut and therefore, no further orders are required to be passed in the present writ petition.

Accordingly, in view of the above, the present writ petition along with the CM applications are disposed of.
