Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for transfer the Revision Petition No. 52 of 2020 Annexure P-4 dated 19.10.2020 pending before Sessions Judge, Kapurthala, which is filed against the order dated 07.10.2020 passed by the Chief Judicial Magistrate Kapurthala in FIR No. 74 dated 13.04.2018 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC registered at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, to a court of competent jurisdiction at Chandigarh.

It is contended that there are several matters pending inter se the parties arising out of the matrimonial dispute which are either pending in Chandigarh or there are various transfer applications that have been filed regarding transfer of the cases from Kapurthala to Chandigarh.

Notice of motion.

Mr. A. S. Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab appearing through the medium

of video conferencing accepts notice on behalf of the respondent No.2-State.

At this stage, Mr. Vivek Thakur, Advocate appearing for respondent No. 1 would contend that the matter sought to be transferred from Kapurthala to Chandigarh has already arrived at the stage of final arguments and listed for arguments tomorrow i.e.24.08.2021.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the paper book.

Undoubtedly, the divorce petition has been transferred to Chandigarh from Kapurthala by the Hon’ble Apex Court and there are other matters too, wherein the petitioner has sought transfer from Kapurthala to Chandigarh. However, since this revision petition filed at the behest of the petitioner himself against order dated 07.10.2020 passed by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala directing the Investigating Officer to hand over the sale proceeds of Zen car and fixed deposits to respondent No.2 has already arrived at the stage of final arguments, no fruitful purpose would be served in transferring the present matter, at this stage.

Consequently, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the revisional Court at Kapurthala to decide the matter expeditiously and preferably within a period of four weeks.
