Status report filed by the State is ordered to be taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner restricts the prayer made in the present petition to the prayer of the petitioner for granting him bail in Complaint No.22835/2013 dated 24.10.2013, titled as Amrik Kaur vs. Gurjit Singh and others, under Sections 3 (X) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and Sections 323, 379, 506, 34 IPC. He further submits that qua the other prayers, the petitioner be granted liberty to raise them before the trial court at an appropriate stage.

On 16.09.2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

Through this application, the applicant seeks to place on record his voter I-card, passport and ration card as Annexures P-5 to P-7.

Allowed as prayed for.

CRM stands disposed of.

Main case

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner was never served in the complaint case in which he has been declared a proclaimed offender as the petitioner's address given in the complaint was wrong and in this regard attention of this Court is drawn to the given address of the petitioner in voter I-card, passport and ration card.

Notice of motion for 15.11.2021.

Mr.J.S.Ghumman, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent No.1 and prays for time to argue the matter.

Respondent No.2 be served through ordinary process.

In the meanwhile, subject to the petitioner's appearing before the Trial Court within ten days from today, she be admitted to ad interim bail to the Trial Court's satisfaction which shall insist on heavy local sureties."

In pursuance to the afore quoted order, the petitioner has appeared before the trial court on 24.09.2021 and on such appearance, she has been admitted to ad-interim bail to the trial court's satisfaction.

In the light of the above, the order of this Court dated 16.09.2021, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is ordered to be made absolute.

Qua the other issues raised in the instant petition, the petitioner is granted liberty to raise them before the trial court at an appropriate stage in her trial.
