The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Rajneesh Bahl, stated to be aged approximately 55 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the impugned promotion order dated 10.09.2020 (Annexure P-13) to the post of Deputy Superintendent (Civil), passed by respondent No.2.

Records of the case show that vide order dated 16.09.2020, notice of motion was issued.

In response to the notice issued, respondents No.1 to 3 have filed the reply dated 10.11.2020 through respondent No.3. In the reply, it has been *inter alia* submitted that the departmental enquiry has been concluded and vide order dated 15.09.2020, passed after filing of the present petition, the

Authorities by taking a lenient view, have decided to issue warning to the petitioner. It has been further submitted that vide order dated 29.09.2020, the petitioner has been promoted w.e.f. 10.09.2020 as Deputy Superintendent (Civil). Both the orders have been appended as Annexures R-1 & R-2 respectively.

In the reply and as per learned counsel for the State, it has been submitted that in view of the above, substantive relief has already been granted to the petitioner and thus, no further orders are called for in the present petition.

The Writ Petition is accordingly disposed of as no further orders are called for.
