On 24.08.2021, the following order was passed:-

“This petition has been filed by the wife seeking the transfer of the petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing No.HMA/196/2020, titled as 'Varun Kanojia vs. Neha' pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Jalandhar to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Hisar.

The petitioner claims that she got married to the respondent on 29.11.2017. She claims that at present, she alongwith her minor child, is residing with her parents at Hisar and cannot properly defend the petition at Jalandhar as the distance between the two places is 300 kms.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that the respondent (husband) is already facing trial in two cases in District Courts, Hisar i.e. FIR No. 103, dated 05.09.2020 registered under Section 34, 323, 406, 498-A, 506 IPC and a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C.

Notice of motion for 14.09.2021.

The liberty is granted to the petitioner to serve the respondent through his counsel in District Court, Jalandhar.

The facts in the order dated 24.08.2021 are not disputed.

Hence, the proceedings of petition filed under Section 9 of the

Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing No.HMA/196/2020, titled as 'Varun

Kanojia vs. Neha' pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Jalandhar, is ordered to be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Hisar.

The transferor Court is requested to remit the case file to the transferee Court forthwith.

The parties through their counsels are directed to appear before the transferee Court on 14.10.2021.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
