ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 53 dated 16.01.2019, under Sections 395 and 397 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, besides Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Sadar Nuh, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the complainant had been robbed of ₹15,000/- along with two ATM cards at gunpoint. The petitioner is not named in the FIR. He has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of co-accused. Besides the statement of co-accused, there is no material which would connect the petitioner with the alleged commission of offence. The petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

This Court, by the order dated 19.08.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail

to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Satbir Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 19.08.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
