Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is not arguing the present revision petition on merits but restricts his prayer for reduction of the sentence awarded to the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has been awarded the sentence of rigorous imprisonment for a period of 02 years alongwith fine.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, as three innocent persons have lost their life due to the irresponsible actions of the petitioner, no leniency is deserved by the petitioner from this Court. Nothing has been pointed out by learned counsel for the petitioner as to how, the sentence imposed upon the petitioner is on excessive side.

No ground is made out to interfere in any manner with sentence imposed upon the petitioner.

Accordingly, the revision petition is dismissed.

As the main revision petition is dismissed, applications i.e.
CRM-26214-2021 and CRM-26215-2021 also stand dismissed.
