The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 Pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.40 dated 22.07.2021, registered for offence under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 82 of the Registration Act, 1908, at Police Station Mukandpur, District SBS Nagar (Annexure P-1).

Having argued the petition for some time and realizing that the Court is not inclined to agree with the submissions made, counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition. He, however, submits that he has instructions that the petitioner will surrender before the trial Court within a period of one week and move a petition seeking grant of regular bail.

Request of the counsel has been considered.

Let the petitioner surrender before the trial Court within a period of one week from today and file a petition seeking grant of regular bail. In case, he does so, the trial Court shall make an endeavour and decide the petition within a period of three days from the date of its filing.
