The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing respondent No. 2 to withdraw its letter dated 04.07.2019 (Annexure P-3) for making recovery of excess pension payment of Rs.23,09,195/- from pension account of the petitioner; to issue writ of *mandamus* directing respondent No. 3 to withdraw its demand notice dated 14.10.2019 (Annexure P-4) and giving directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 not to make any kind of deduction or

recovery from pension account of the petitioner, for which, legal notice dated 13.07.2021 (Annexure P-9) has also been served upon the respondent authorities.

Heard.

In the light of oral submissions of the petitioner's side the directions are issued to the respondents No. 1 and 2 to duly consider legal notice dated 13.07.2021 (Annexure P-7) as representation of petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.
