Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to respondent No.5 to consider the grievances of petitioner thereby lodging FIR against accused persons and to investigate the same in an independent and unbiased manner with further direction to constitute Special Investigation Team (SIT).

Learned counsel for petitioner contended that regarding the same grievance, father of petitioner made representation on 16.03.2020 to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab, Sector-9, Chandigarh, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/4, but still no action has been taken. He further submits that grievance of petitioner would be redressed if representation dated 16.03.2020 (Annexure P/4) is ordered to be disposed of in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab, Sector-9, Chandigarh, to look into and decide representation dated 16.03.2020 (Annexure P/4) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within eight weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
