AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

By this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.55, dated 04.05.2016, registered at Police Station City Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, alleging therein the commission of the offences punishable under Sections 325, 323 and 34 of the IPC, as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of a compromise (Annexure P-2), arrived at between the petitioners and respondent no.2

Pursuant to the order of this Court dated November 05, 2020, the report of the learned SDJM, Malout, dated 19.10.2020, is on record, stating therein that respondent no.2, i.e. the complainant in the FIR, Meena Rani, appeared before that court alongwith the petitioners, i.e. the accused, on 05.10.2020, with all of them having made statements to the effect that they had compromised the matter with each other.

As per the assessment of that court, the compromise is seen to have been arrived at between the parties without any threat or undue influence.

That being so, looking at the nature of the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioners and the fact that the matter has been compromised between the petitioners and the complainant, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.55, dated 04.05.2016, registered at Police Station City Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, alleging therein the commission of the offences punishable under Sections 325, 323 and 34 of the IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
