Case heard by video conferencing

By this petition, the petitioner seeks the issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing respondents no.1 to 4 to protect their lives and liberty and also not to harass and humiliate them at the behest of respondent no.5.

On December 07, 2020, the following order had been passed:-

“All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

A reply having been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, it is stated therein that a complaint was received which is being enquired into, to determine as to whether there are any cognizable offences made out or not and as such, no case has been registered against the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners first submits that she has

received no instructions after the last date of hearing from the petitioners, but still seeks further accommodation.

Adjourned to 25.01.2021, with it made clear that the enquiry would continue as per law, but if the petitioners are to be summoned, it shall be by issuing notices in terms of the provisions of the Cr.P.C., with the notices shown to be served upon them.”

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners today submits that the petitioners do not want to pursue this petition further.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
