Application is allowed and the affidavit of complainant, namely, Bhajan Singh S/o Balwant Singh as Annexure P-3 is taken on record.

CRM-M-28655-2020

This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.93 dated 21.10.2019, under Sections 306, 458, 506, 511, 34 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Kheri Gandian, District Patiala (Punjab).

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that he has been falsely implicated in the present FIR as would be evident by the affidavit furnished by the complainant in these proceedings, wherein the complainant has affirmed that the petitioner herein and his wife were not responsible for the death that took place, of the wife of the complainant, who is none other than the mother of the petitioner herein. Learned counsel further submits that the matter already stands investigated and challan presented and charges have been framed and therefore, his custody would no longer be required.

Learned counsel for the complainant affirms that the affidavit that has been filed in these proceedings has been filed by the complainant himself and she would have no objection, if regular bail is allowed to the petitioner herein.

I have heard counsel for the parties and have also perused case file.

Keeping in view the affidavit furnished by the complainant and the stage of the case, as noticed above, I deem it appropriate to allow the petitioner benefit of bail, at this stage. The petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
