Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India for issuance of directions to official respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.4.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is 92 years of age and he had a son who went missing in August, 2008 and has been presumed to have died by virtue of judgment and decree dated 05.08.2016 passed by the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Ludhiana as he has not been seen or heard for the last more than 07 years. As per the counsel, respondent No.4, who is the nephew of the petitioner, has been pressurizing and threatening the petitioner to transfer his share of the immovable property in his favour. Counsel further submits that petitioner has submitted a representation dated 02.07.2021, Annexure P-5, to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No.2, which has not yielded any result. He submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, in case, a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into the representation dated 02.07.2021, Annexure P-5.

Request made by counsel has been considered.

Without examining the allegations made in the writ petition or in the representation submitted by the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, respondent No.2. to examine the representation dated 02.07.2021, Annexure P-5, and take suitable action thereon as warranted, in accordance with law.

A copy of the order as well as copy of the representation be sent to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana - respondent No.2, in order to enable him to do the needful within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the copy of the order.
