Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.126 dated 29.06.2021 under Section 3 of SC&ST Act and Section 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Saha, District Ambala.

While granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners, following order was passed by this Court on 20.08.2021: -

“...Learned Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the case which was registered with undue and unexplained delay of 6 days as the alleged occurrence took place on 23.06.2021 and the FIR was

registered on 29.06.2021. Injuries were also caused to petitioner No.1 by the opposite party regarding which petitioner No.1 was medico legally examined but no FIR has been registered against the complainant. Petitioner No.2 submitted complaints on CM Window, Haryana against Naveen Kumar, Sarpanch regarding issuance of fake BPL Cards and due to making of such complaints, Naveen Kumar got the present FIR registered through his servant Ajmer Singh. No prima facie case as to commission of offence under Section 3 of the SC/ST Act is made out. The petitioners are ready to join the investigation...”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of status report by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ambala Cantt, filed in the Court today, has submitted that a cancellation report has already been prepared.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the order dated 20.08.2021 passed by this Court, vide which interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioners, is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
