The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 0108 dated 09.07.2020, under Section 420 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is the outcome of a monetary dispute which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised. He also contends that a draft of ₹2,00,000/- shall be handed over to the complainant today itself and the petitioner shall make the remaining payment as per the schedule in the compromise.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court by order dated 29.09.2020 had directed the petitioner to appear before the investigating officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on *ad interim* bail to the satisfaction of the investigating/arresting officer,

subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Karamjit Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 20.09.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
