Petitioner-Ginder Singh, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents especially respondents No.2 to 5, to sanction the mutation of the inheritance of late Ishar Singh (grandfather of the petitioner) in accordance with law, especially keeping in view the Division Bench judgment dated 15.10.1970 (Annexure P-1), passed by this Court and order dated 03.07.2006 (Annexure P-3) and further to finalize the said proceedings within a time bound manner, as despite being declared owner by this Court, respondents No.2 to 5 are not sanctioning the mutation. Further prayers have also been made as mentioned in the prayer clause of the present writ petition.

Today, CM-4288-2021, has been listed on behalf of the applicant-petitioner *inter alia* with a prayer for withdrawal of the present writ petition.

Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner, by making specific reference to para 2 of the application, submits that the petitioner had entered into compromise with respondents No.6,7 &8, therefore, he does not want to pursue the present writ petition.

Notice of the application.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Nikhil Chopra, Additional AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed.

In view of the above, the main writ petition is taken up on board today itself i.e. 18.03.2021 and the same is dismissed as withdrawn.
