The petitioner in the present writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeks consideration of the representation for mutual transfer dated 11.01.2021 (Annexure P-5).

A perusal of the paper-book would go on to show that the petitioner is working as Assistant Professor of History in Government College for Women, Bahadurgarh (Jhajjar). She wants to get mutual transfer with Ms. Priyanka Aggarwal, Assistant Professor of History of Government College for Women, Jassaur Kheri (Jhajjar), who had completed her five years mandatory rural service. The petitioner in her request has stated that she is unmarried and has to look after her parents and there is no rural college near her village and, therefore, she wants to complete her rural service.

The said request seems to be genuine to the extent that the State has a willing candidate to work in the rural area.

Keeping in view the above, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose will be served to call upon the respondents for filing reply, as it would only cause delay in deciding the proceedings.
