This is a petition for regular bail filed on behalf of the
petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.0096 dated 08.07.2021,
under Sections 153-A, 505(2) & 120-B of the IPC (Sections 336 of the IPC
and 25(1)(b)(a) & 30 of the Arms Act added later on), registered at Police
Station Balongi, District SAS Nagar.

[2]. The petitioner has remained in detention in the present case for
exactly 2 months, since 08.07.2021.

[3]. After completion of the investigation, Challan against the
petitioner has already been submitted.

[4]. All the offences imputed to the petitioner are triable by the

Magistrate's Court. The FIR in question was drawn up on the complaint of a Police Officer himself on the basis of a secret information. The witnesses cited largely happen to be all the Police Personnel. Consequently, there is a little possibility of the petitioner exercising any undue threat or pressure upon them. As such, his further detention for an indefinite period is not called for.

[5]. For the aforesaid reasons and without commenting any further on the merits of the present case as a whole, but in view of the detention undergone by the petitioner, the prayer of the petitioner for regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
