The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioners have come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the petitioners one notional increment for the pensionary benefits on the completion of one full year of service, for which, representation dated 24.02.2020 (Annexure P-5) has also been submitted before the respondent authorities.

If the petitioners are held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to them without any delay.
