Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.382 dated 26.08.2020 registered under Sections 323, 354, 506 and 34 IPC, at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

This Court, on 18.09.2020, passed the following order:

“Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 382 dated 26.08.2020 registered under Sections 323, 354, 506 and 34 IPC, at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that a scuffle took place in the village and only attribution to the petitioner is that he had pushed the complainant due to which she fell down. The complainant raised a noise upon which her husband reached there. He further states that the

complainant is a Constable in Haryana Police and the petitioner, other co-accused and the complainant are from same family and residents of same village.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Ramesh Kumar Ambavta, AAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. He, on the instructions from ASI Kiranpal Kaur, submits that there are serious allegations against the petitioner i.e. he pushed the complainant due to which she fell down and received injuries.

Adjourned to 12.01.2021.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and if he is sought to be arrested, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer subject to the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 18.09.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from S.I. Kiranpal Kaur, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is now not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 18.09.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
