Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner on the post of Sweeper with consequential benefits.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, states that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case representation (P-2) is considered and decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the aforesaid representation (P-2) in

accordance with law by passing speaking order preferably within a period of four months from today.
