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**B.S. Walia, J.(Oral)**

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been handed over a draft for a sum of Rs.7,20,000/- by learned counsel for the respondent on account of arrears of maintenance in terms of order dated 25.10.2017 passed by this Court and in the circumstances, the contempt petition may be disposed of as not calling for any further orders.

2. Mr. Sukhdev Kamboj, Advocate for Mr. Bikramjit Singh Patwalia, Advocate for the respondent states that non compliance within the stipulated period of time was not intentional but due to circumstances beyond the control of the respondent inter alia amongst others on account of coronavirus pandemic but in view of needful having been done the contempt petition be disposed of as not calling for any further orders.

3. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel and am of the view that in the circumstances, non compliance within the stipulated period of time was not intentional or willful.
4. In view of the position noted above, Rule is discharged and the Contempt Petition is disposed of as not calling for any further orders.
