terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer
for issuance of appropriate writ in the nature of *mandamus* for
issuance of directions to the respondents to release subsidy amount
to the petitioner Cooperative Society as the said Society (PACS) had
purchased agricultural equipments after raising loan/financial
assistance from the Bank in the year 2018 in pursuant to the
approval for subsidy given by respondents to the said Society.
