Due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, the instant case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer for issuance of appropriate writ in the nature of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to pay a sum of Rs.7,34,137/- as balance amount of retiral benefits along with interest at the rate of 18% per annum from 31.03.2020 on the delayed payment till realization be released to the petitioner.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the respondents to consider the legal notice dated 06.01.2021 (Annexure P-2) as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
